



DISCOVER PATAGONIA CRUCEROS AUSTRALIS

04 days / 03 Nights

Itinerary:

1-Ushuaia

Check-in from 10:00 to 17:00 hrs. at 160 calle Juan Manuel de Rosas.

2016-2017 season: boarding at 17:30 hrs.

2017-2018 season: boarding at 18:00 hrs.

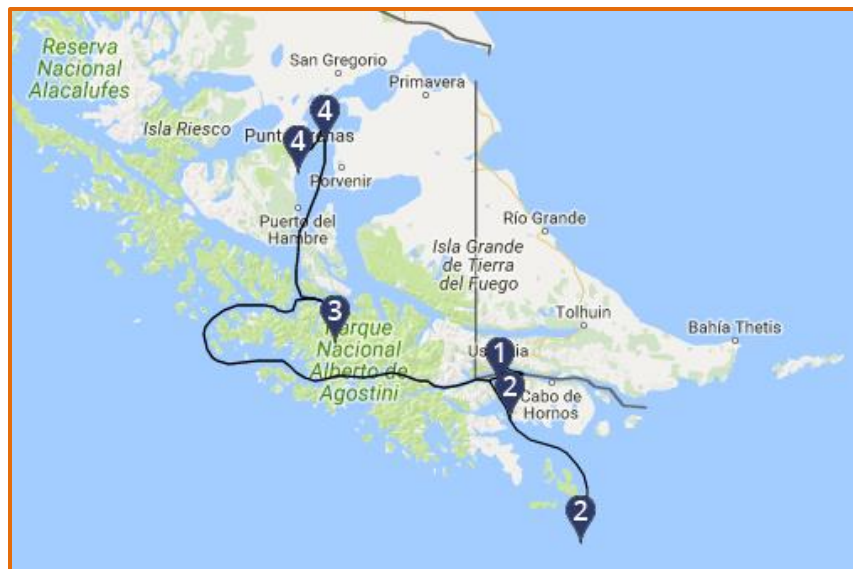
Welcome cocktail and presentation of the captain and crew. Subsequently, the ship set sail towards the southern end. Through the mythical Beagle Channel and Strait of Magellan, go over the Patagonia and Tierra del Fuego.

Day 2 Cape Horn - Wulaia Bay

We sail through the Murray channel and Nassau Bay reaching the national Cape Horn Park, where we will land if weather conditions allow it. The mythical Cape Horn was discovered in 1616 and is an almost vertical headland of 425 metres in height. For years it was a major navigation route for sailing between the Atlantic and Pacific oceans. It is known as "the end of the world" and it was declared a world biosphere reserve in the year 2005. In the afternoon we will disembark at Wulaia Bay, historic site that was one of the largest of the native Yámana canoe settlements. Charles Darwin, naturalist English, landed here in 1833 during his journey aboard the HMS Beagle. This place offers a visual spectacle of great beauty for its vegetation and geography. We reach a lookout point, walking through a Magellanic forest growing lengas, Coigües, canelos and ferns, among other species.

Day 3 Agostini sine - glacier-Eagle

Sail occasion, Brecknock, Cockburn and Magdalena channel to finally enter the seno De Agostini, from where it will be possible to appreciate the glaciers that descend from the heart of the Cordillera Darwin, some of them reaching the sea. In the afternoon we will go to the glacier Eagle where we will disembark in Zodiac boats for a gentle walk through the rainforest cold Patagonian until arriving in front of the Eagle glacier.



Day 4 Magdalena Island - Punta Arenas

First thing in the morning we will disembark at Magdalena Island, weather conditions permitting, stop liable for the supply of former navigators and discoverers. During our hike to the lighthouse we can appreciate an immense colony of Magellanic penguins. In April and September, this excursion is replaced by a landing on Isla Marta, where you can see South American sea lions from the Zodiac boats. Finally, you arrive to Punta Arenas, landing at 11:30 hrs.
